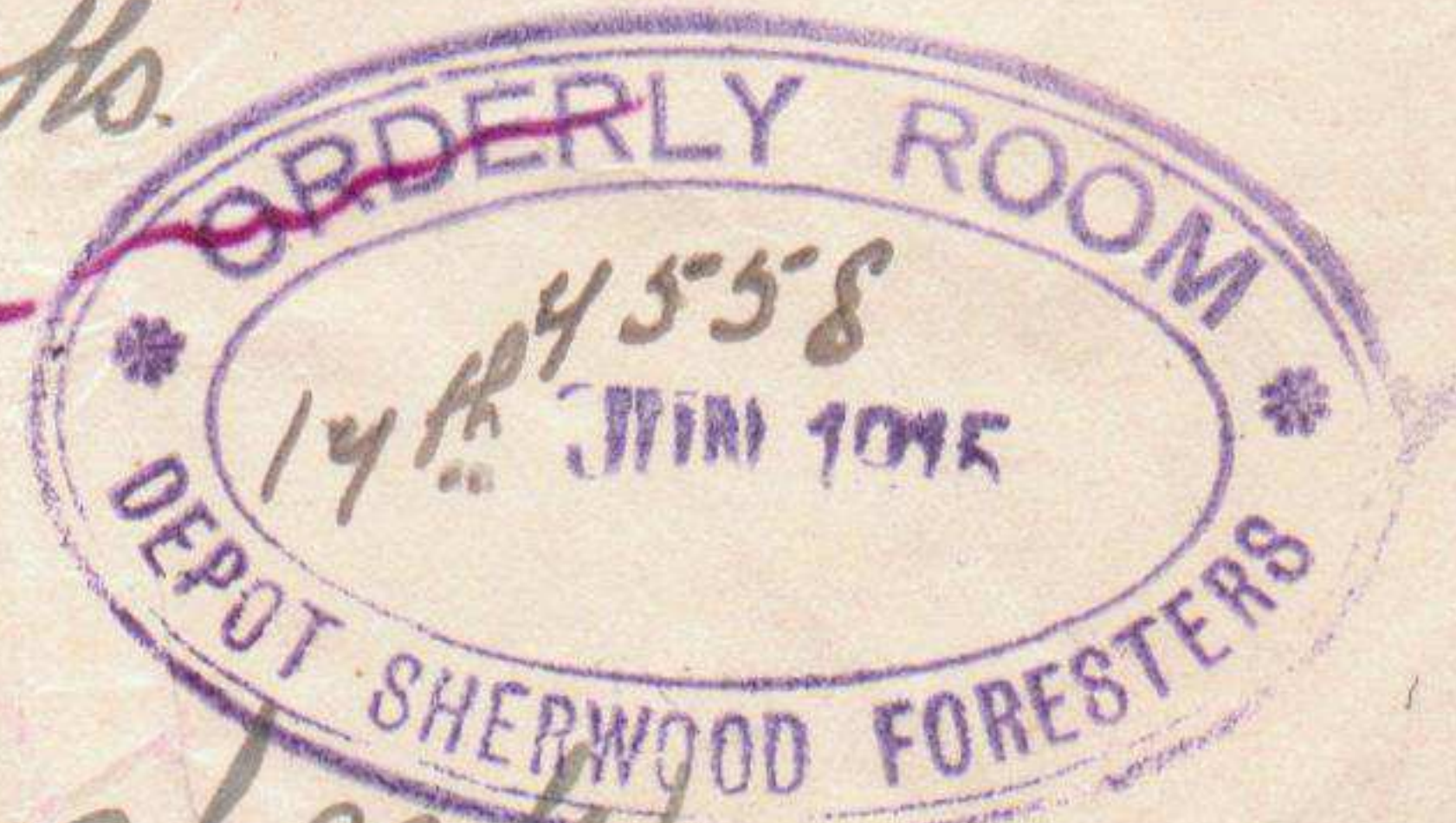

The Officer Commanding, 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion Sherwood Foresters at Sunderland, has been notified that you have been issued with a Railway Warrant and should join his Battalion on the above date.

Copy of War Office letter: No Extension of Furlough will be granted. You must report yourself as directed.
