

SUTER, Frederick John

The envelope scans on this page refer to Frederick Suter's (short) time in the RFC/RAF.

They are all addressed to him at Bath (in the same hand of his future wife) and give his new Service Number (183535) and Squadron No. (first 7 Squadron, and later 5 Squadron).

His eye test for the RFC at Bath (which he passed) is dated 5th October 1918, and the letters below are postmarked 14th October 1918, 14th December 1918 and 3rd January 1919 showing he was in the RFC/RAF until at least that date.

Later in 1919, when applying for a vehicle licence, he gave his address as 21 Milton Street, Balderton, Newark.
